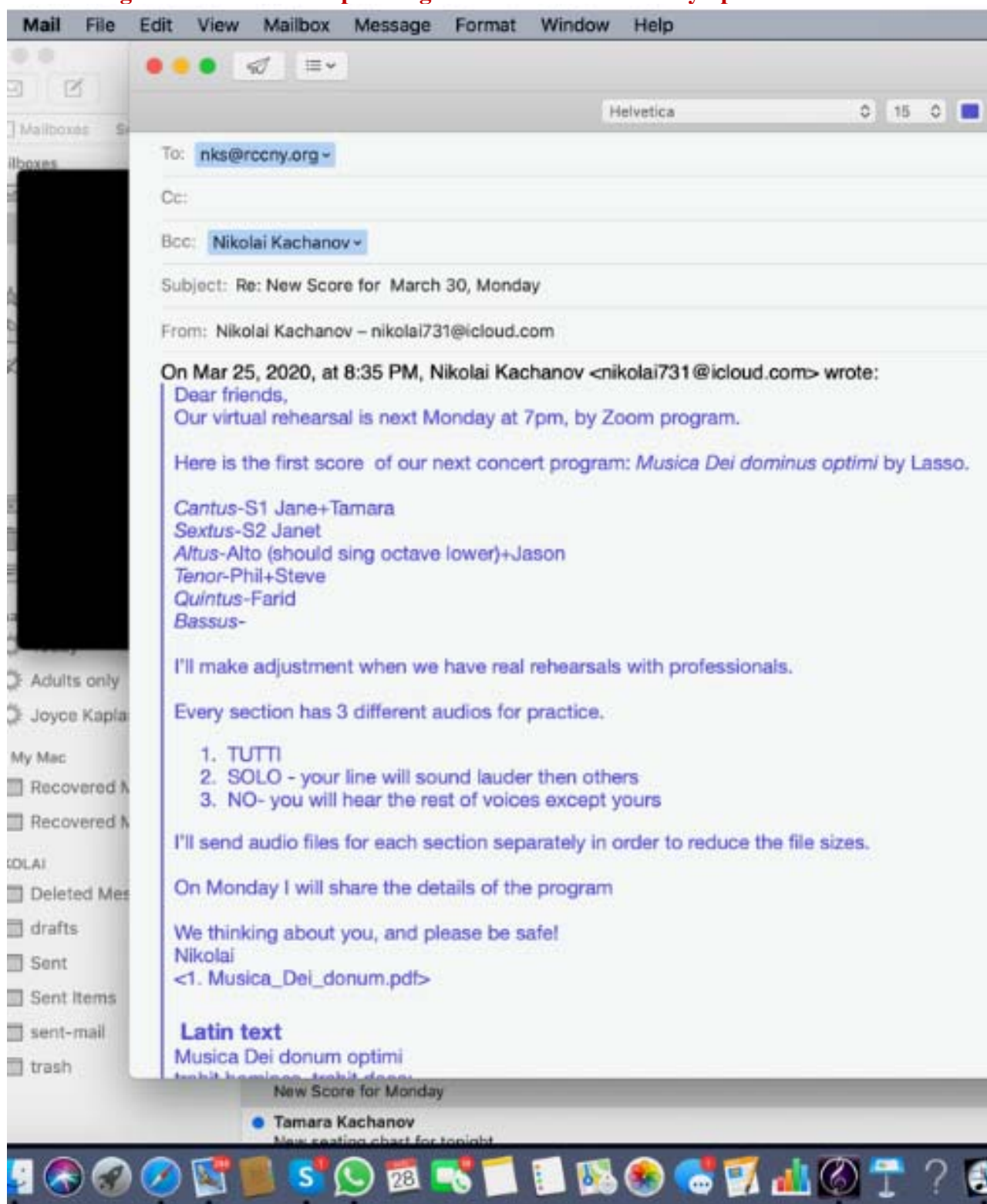

Go to the settings via the up-arrow and be sure your input and output are correct. Another trick I learned during my video voice lesson today: While you are there in audio settings, go to "advanced" button in the settings and click the box that says "show in-meeting option to "enable original sound" from microphone. When it shows up on the screen, enable original sound. This will prevent the sound from cutting out as much as it would otherwise. Finally, (sopranos) when we get into higher frequencies step back (several feet) from the mic to avoid distortion.
